- Visualizing and planning for **A global commons-based global partnership**: What it would look like, what it would do, how it could be financed; **key deliverables**; and **transformative ideas**. Lisinka Ulatowska will lead the session as we visualize and begin to plan how to contribute toward humanity's next evolutionary step: a world that works for all people and nature.
- **Financing for Development and creating systemic change**. Please go to: [www.titanpad.com/commonsfinancing](http://www.titanpad.com/commonsfinancing) and list your ideas. Rob will bring these together in a report which will also list a number of commons approaches to financing. We will be using the document **Unleashing Financing and Other Resources for A World that Works for All People and Nature**. And introduce the idea of how to bring about a systemic economic and social shift. In the above we shall be building on the work done by you on the titanpad last time in our strategy meeting.

### Please find attached:

1. **The Zero Draft on Financing for Development: The draft text for the Addis Ababa Agreement**. This agreement proposes how we finance the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals and the 169 targets. We shall place the financing mechanisms that we decide on on the above titanpad into this document as best fits. You can also place your ideas into this document and make a notice of where you are doing this on the titanpad.
2. **The Technical Report of the UNSC on indicators** for the 17 Goals and Targets. The statistical Commission of the UN has started to work on the indicators that will let us know when we have reached a target. The problem is seen to be that the Commission does not have the expertise with the subject matter that many of you have; you are being asked to help to decide how to measure when a target has been reached. An example could be on Goal 6. **Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all**. Target: 6.6 **By 2020 protect and restore water related ecosystems, including mountains, forests, wetlands, rivers, aquifers and lakes**. **The indicator might read: Percentage of water related ecosystems, including mountains, forests, wetlands, rivers, aquifers and lakes that are returned to pre-1950's natural state**. *Let us know your suggestions and we shall place these in the document and pass them on to the Statistical Commission.*
3. The Summary Report of the workshop we gave at the UN on **Powerful and Innovative Approaches to Financing Development. Commons: Social Solidarity Economies, Shared Societies, Cooperatives and the Internet** since many of you did not receive it. Please pass it on to your networks as you see fit.

This also contains a video of the workshop which was generally considered a great success.

At the conference on the agenda of the High Level Political Forum (the body that will oversee our development for the coming 15 years) Rob Wheeler, Alexandra Akira and I consolidated our working relationship with France, Brazil, Chile and Rwanda . Together we can in all likelihood introduce the commons approaches they together with the Commons Cluster, The International Cooperative Alliance, and the Mont Blanc Meetings Association introduced at the workshop.
