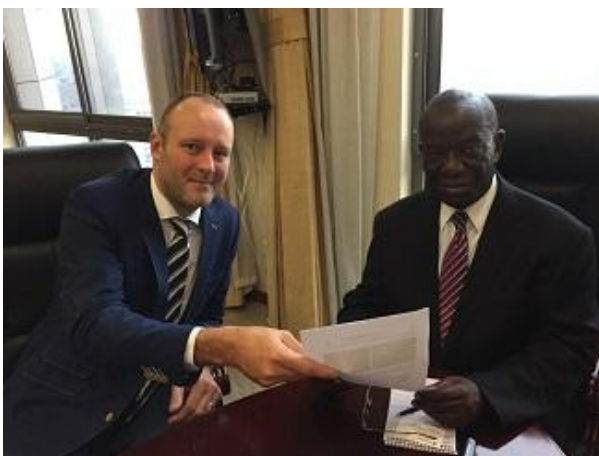
Dear Emile,
