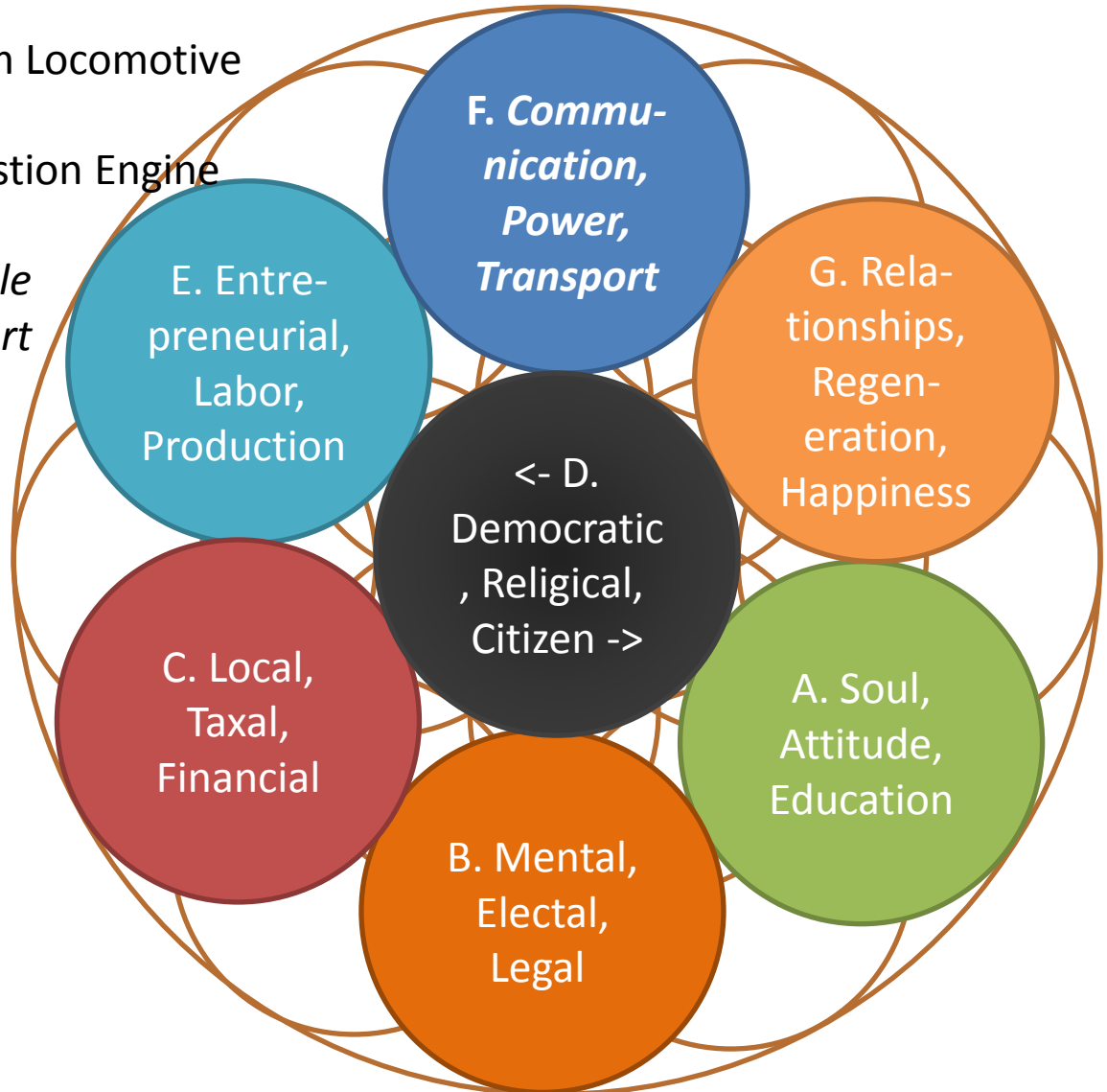

9. Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive and sustainable industrialization and foster innovation

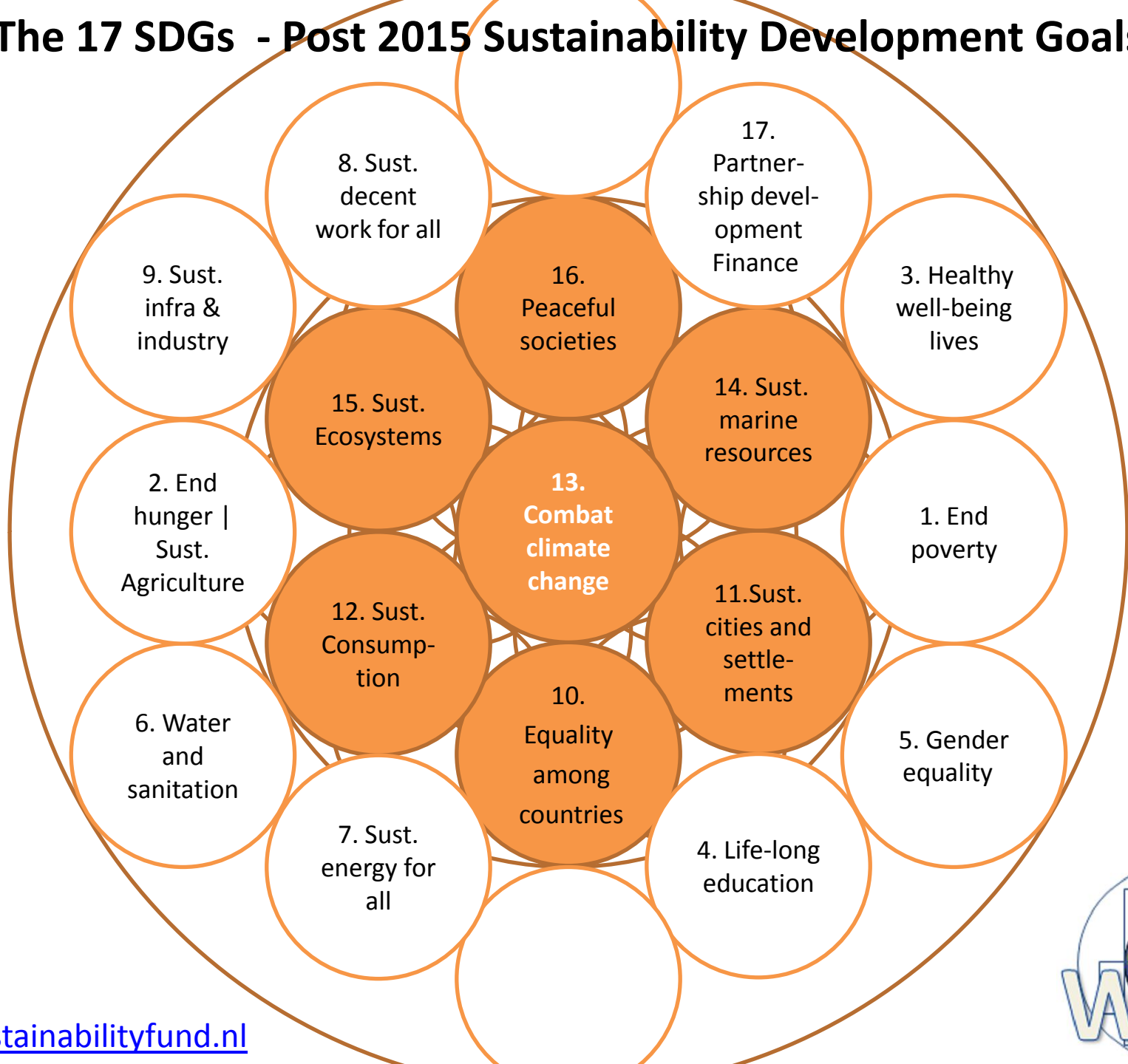

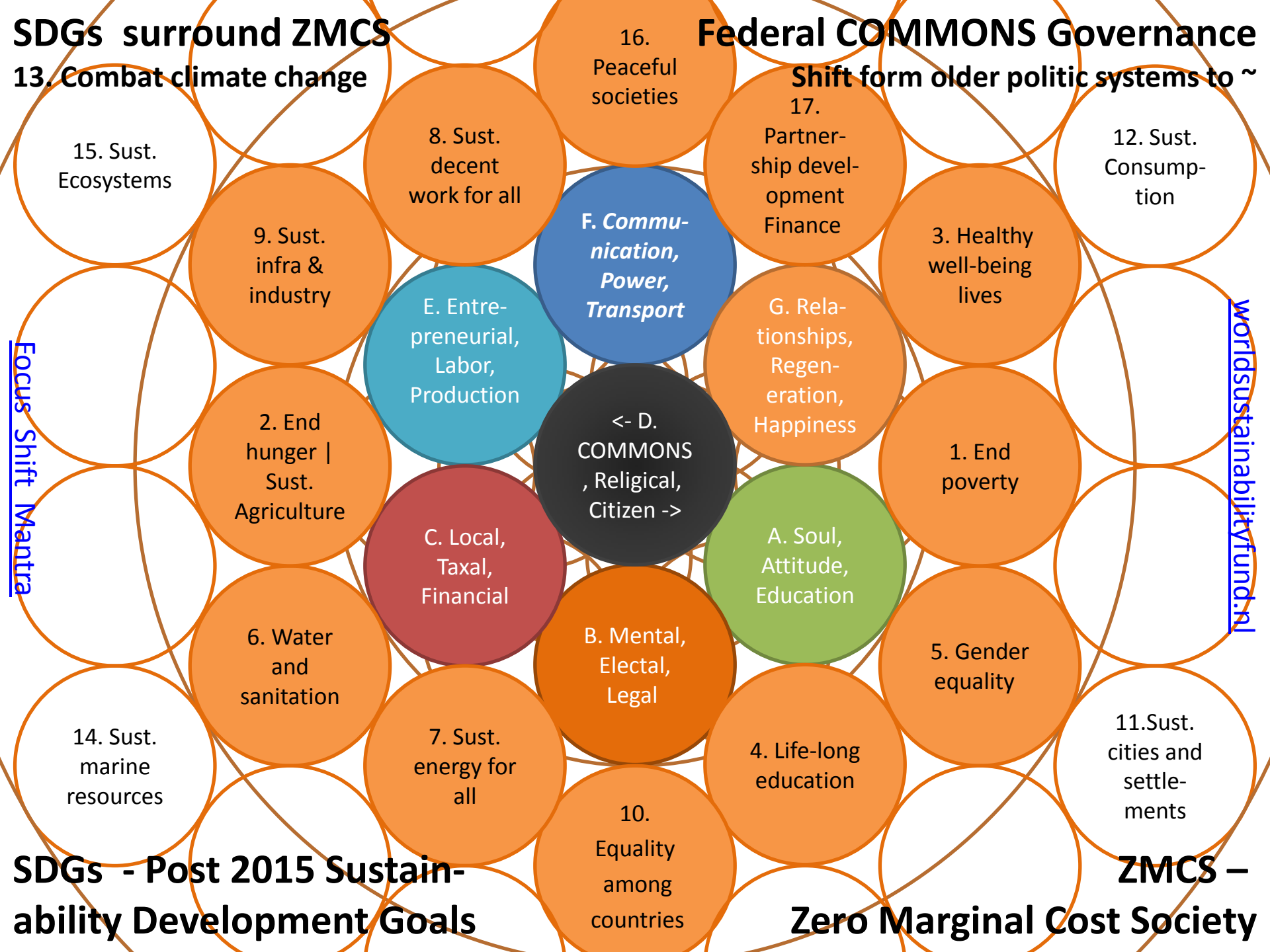

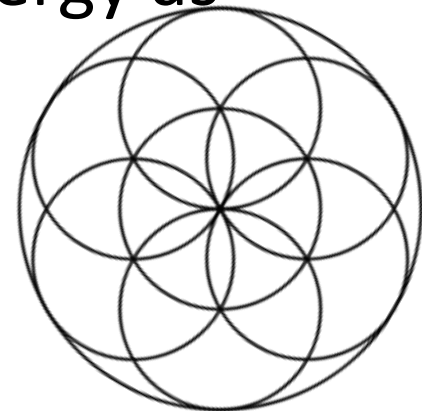

Human Rights - basic info

- In 1948 the United Nations adopted the Universal Declaration of the Human Rights. It contains 30 rights.
- In 2010 Emile van Essen proposed to add 10 Sustainable Human Rights to implement Bronning.



In short Human Rights handles:

1. FREEDOM AND EQUALTY
2. RECOGNITION AND LAW
3. FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT AND NATIONALITY
4. MARRIAGE AND FAMILY
5. PROPERTY, THOUGHT, ASSOCIATION AND GOVERNMENT
6. SOCIAL SECURITY, EMPLOYMENT AND REMUNERATION
7. STANDARD LIVING AND EDUCATION
8. CULTURAL PARTICIPATION AND CREATIVE OWNERSHIP
9. SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY DUTIES
10. SUSTAINABLE ECOSYSTEMS AND LIVING



The Ten Bronning Rights

31. A part of the global land and water will be common wealth to ensure sustainability of nature and species.
32. Everyone has the right to visit (parts of) common nature.
33. Everyone gets (for instance) 1.000 m² of fertile land on which enough sun and water enters to produce good food, healthy living, and land value difference compensation.
34. Everyone gets the right and duty to get and give care to the commons and peoples with disabilities and at age as a local service – part of lifetime activity.
35. Everyone gets free energy in an reasonable amount to has good light, heating and cooling, cleaning, internet, and telephone.
36. Everyone gets a pollution quote and the right on healthy air and surrounding.

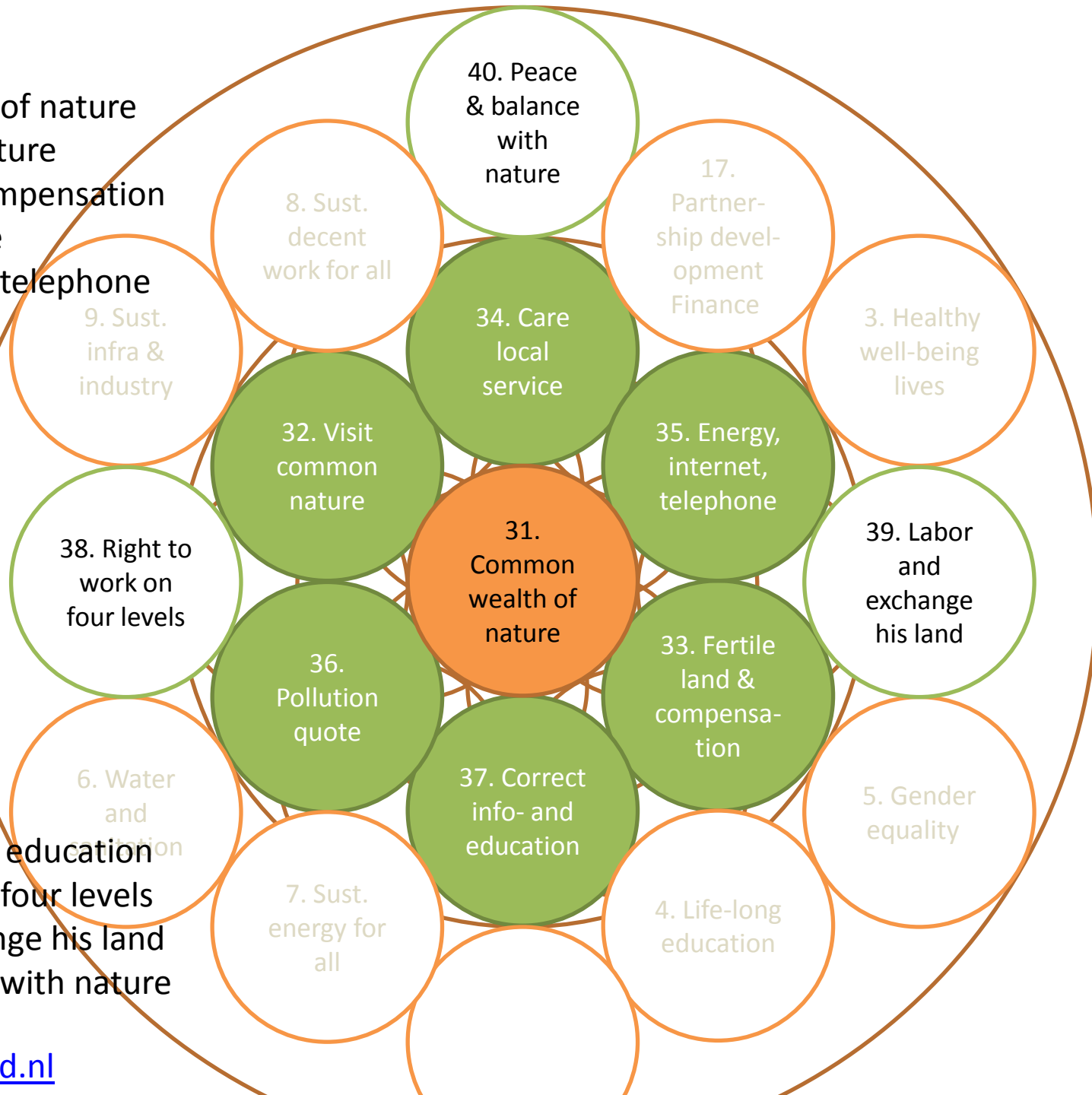


37. Everyone has the right on correct information and sufficient education.
38. Everyone has the right to work on four levels – based on green technology: On his own land; On community services; On social services; On commercial services.
39. Everyone has the right to (let) labor his land, build a house on it and to exchange with others. After dying the land may stay for max. five year in the family. Then it will be free for giving it away to the community which will give it to a new born child.
40. Mankind has the right to live in peace and harmony with nature by finding together the right proportions for the above by becoming aware of interrelationships as population, food, rich natural environment, and the needed spiritual emotional balance.

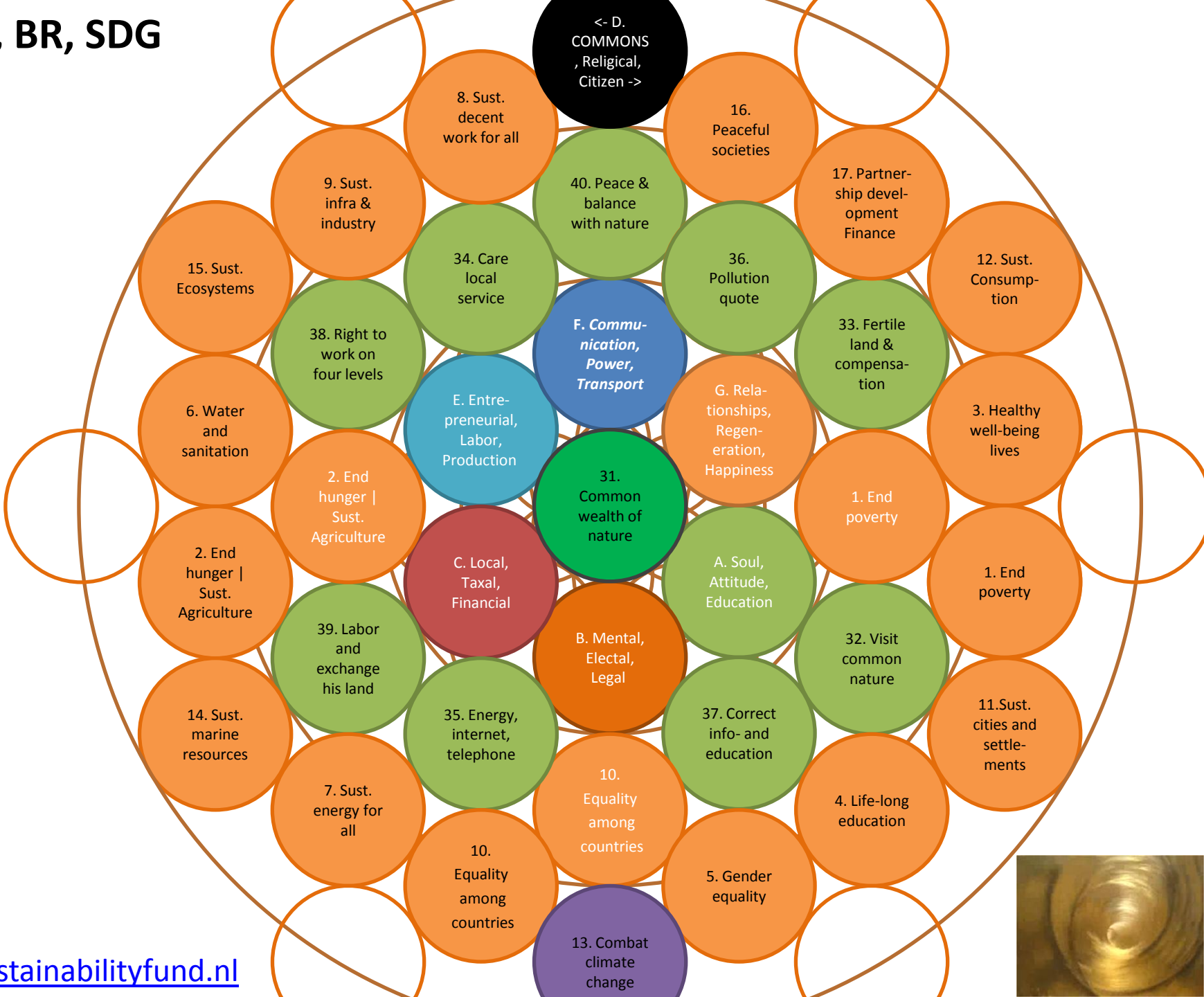

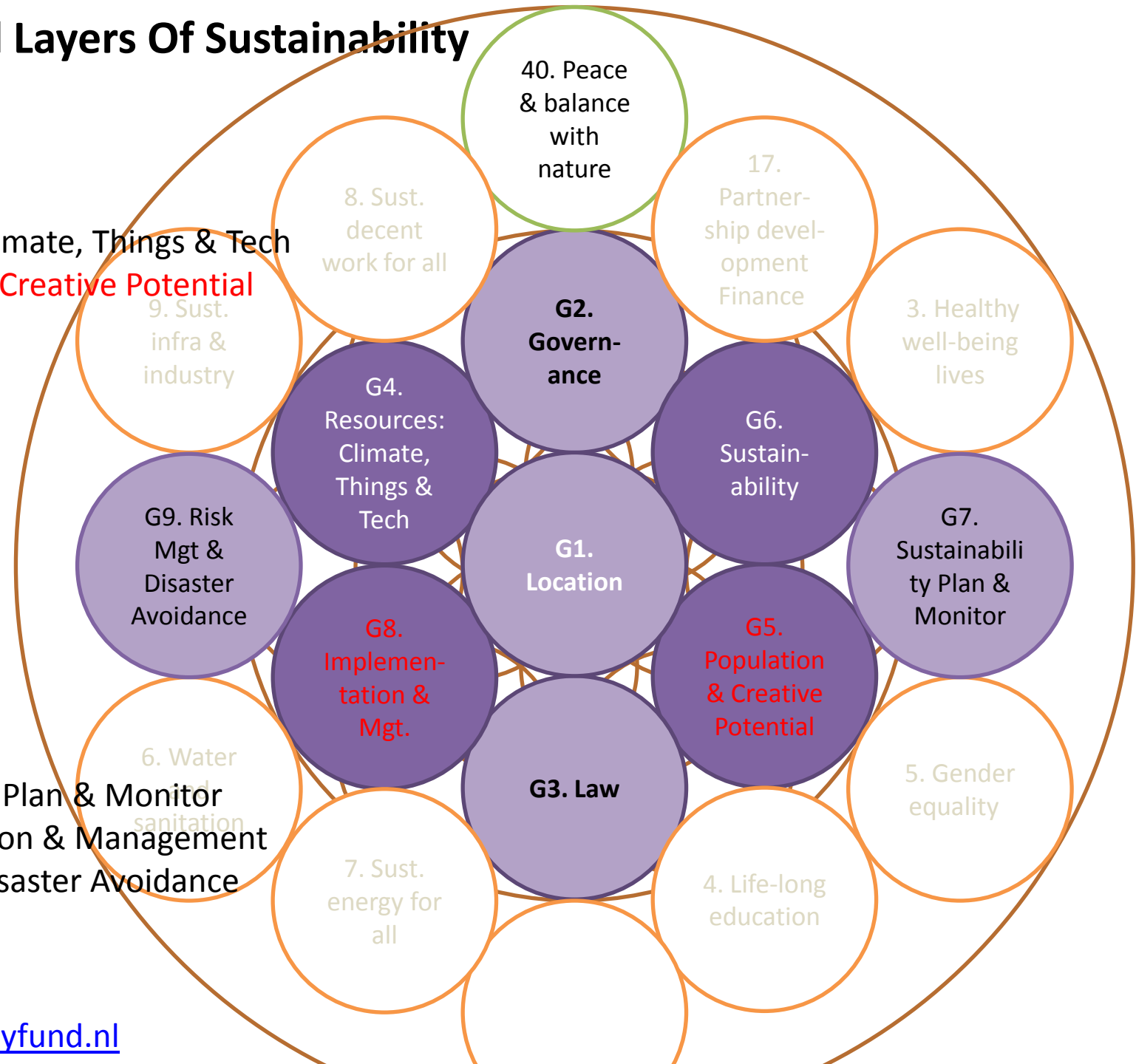

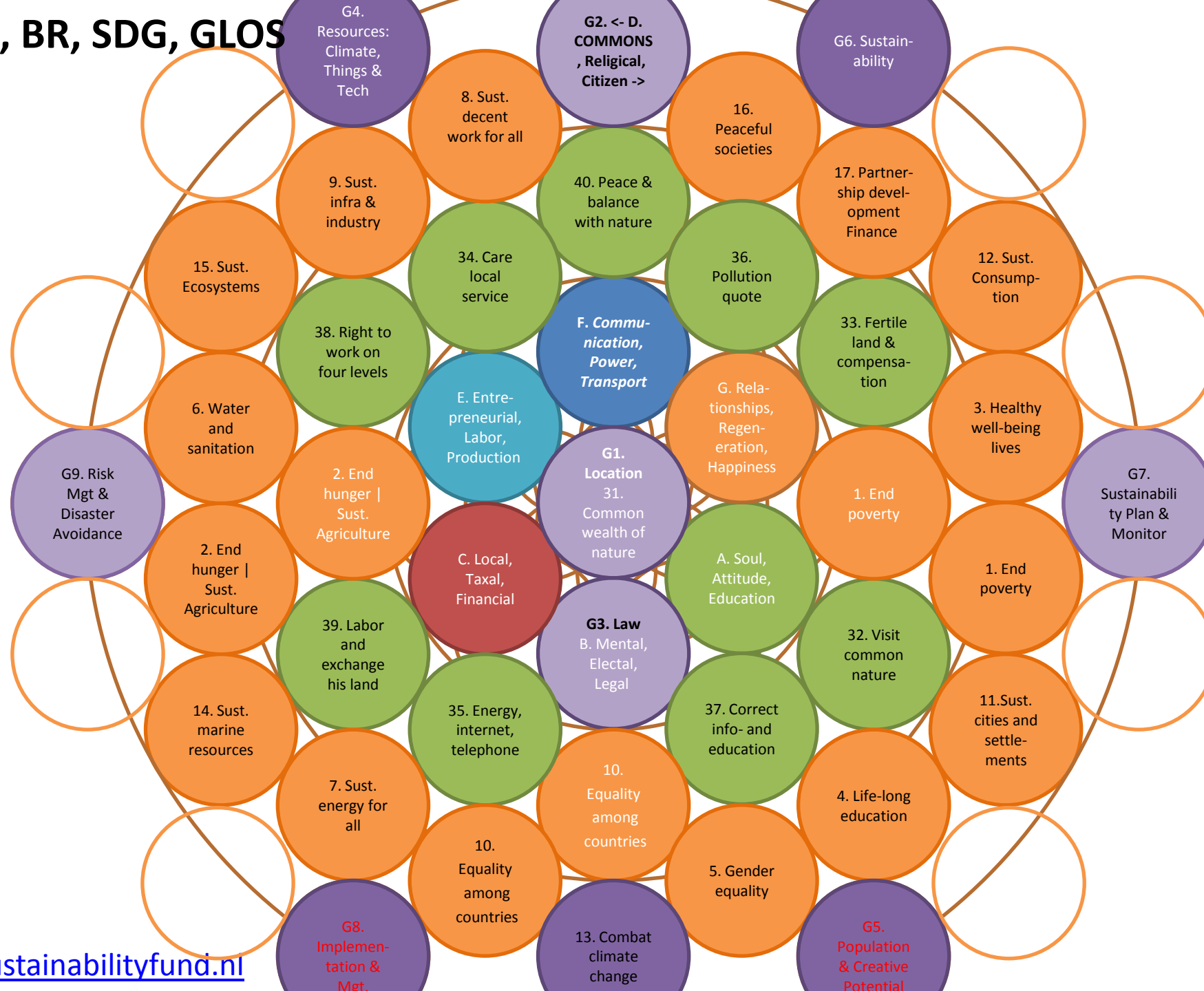

- Wind, sunshine, thermal and water energy



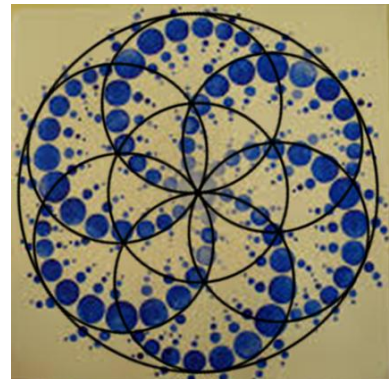
Common problem

- Health, education, and welfare



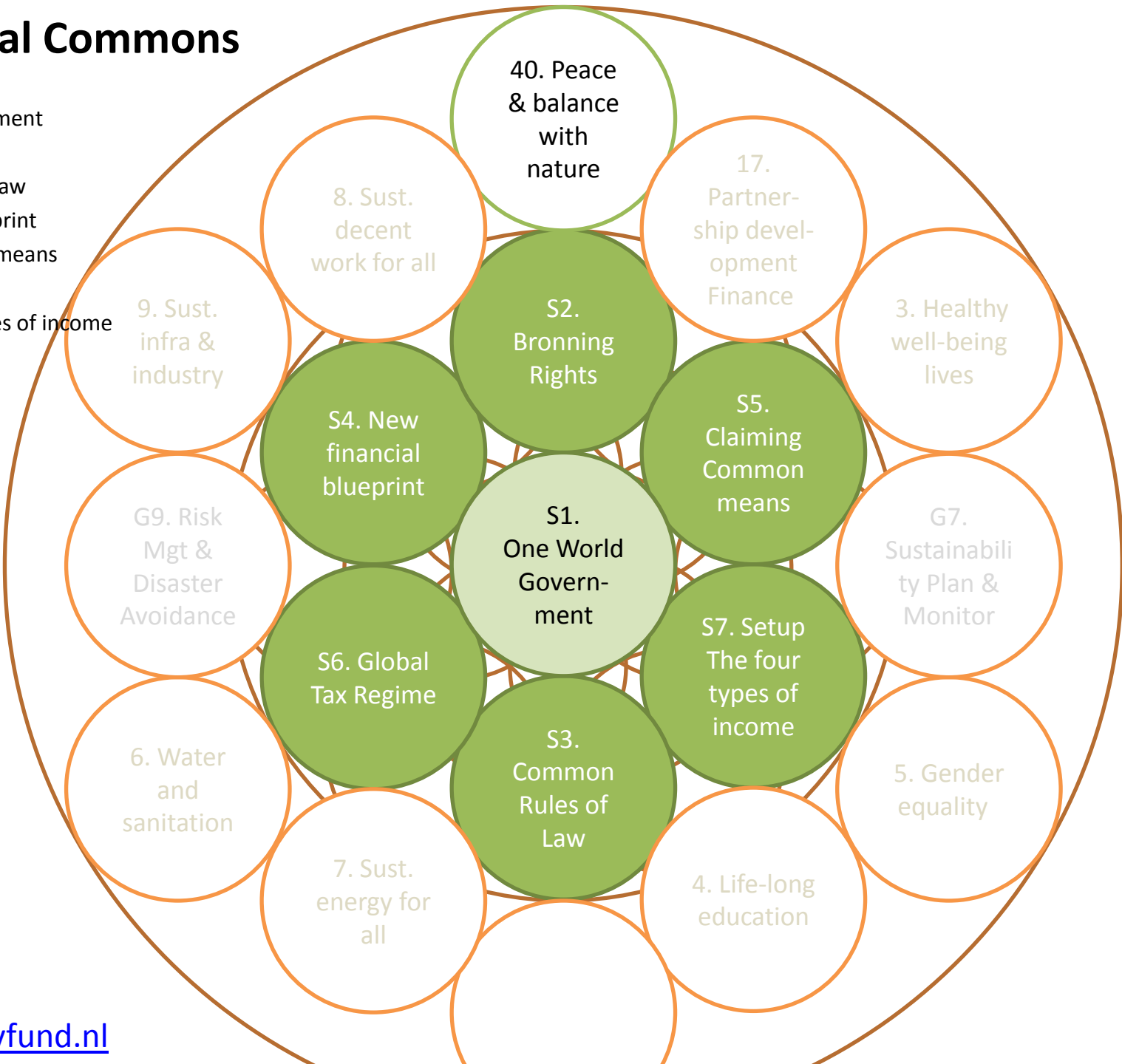

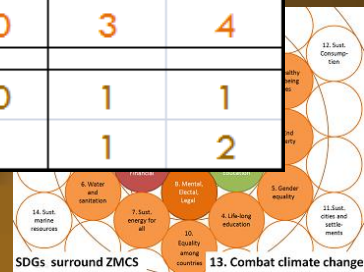

Setup The four types of income

1. Own land income:

- Self housing, harvest, creativity, rest & happiness

2. Community income:

- Mutual services as youth, education & elder care

3. Social income:

- Mutual work on, and use of, common structures

4. Commercial income:

- Rest time free labor creativity, prosuming & sales

5. Philanthropic income:

- Give away & Free receive of over values & happiness



Bronning and Commons aspects

1. Own land income:
 - Land sphere as **own Bron** of existence
2. Community income & 3. Social income:
 - **Common** labor power as **shared Bron** of support
4. Commercial income:
 - Individual and group activities for common luxury and wealth creation with circular sometimes use against payment of natural resources: **crea Bronning**
5. Philanthropic income:
 - **Free Bronning**



Zero Marginal Cost Society

Bronning income on finance

1. **Own land income:** Low +/- tax for land value inequality compensation; hours, installation and harvest based
2. **Community income:** Get hours, make hours, get hours; for all ages, care, education, buddy; No tax, local admin
3. **Social income:** Middle tax in hours or money; p.e. get 80, pay 100, to compensate non hour cost and unabled
4. **Commercial income:** Turn-over added value tax, to support general cost, wealth spread, and conservation
5. **Philanthropic income:** No or low tax, in split or money; tax for registration, wealth spread, and circular economy

The society becomes less financial and more laboral



Global Financial & Tax Blueprint

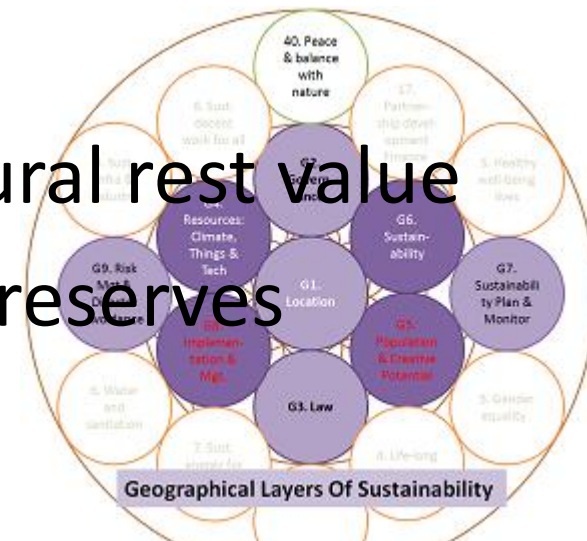
- **Implement Land and Community income** for unemployed, setup support and admin, will create more services, health and happiness, kick starts poverty alleviation
- **Shift step by step to more social production** and income by setup of support, offer easy to transfer jobs; offer financial equivalent consumption possibilities; quote needs
- **Transit to one equal labor hour rate** for each level of education and job heaviness; it makes global commerce prices more equal, which spread jobs and lower transport

All this will lead to lower tax and lean finance



Commons GLOS action on Finance

- **Value Own land lots** and make them free for transition, realize the infrastructure
- **Allow federations** to setup their own Bronning and Commons admin, integrate systems
- **Plan the impact** on financial institutions, prepare them for reorganization
- **Restrict sustainable use** and natural rest value
- Create Own land based pension reserves
